This service, celebrated annually at the start of the new connexional year, is at the heart of Methodists' devotion and discipleship, and our dedication to working for social justice. It celebrates the relationship between humans and the divine, modelled for us in the teaching of Jesus Christ.

The Covenant is the means of grace by which we accept the relationship with God, and then seek to live it out. The spirit of it is summed up in these lines from the Covenant Prayer:

"let me be employed for you, or laid aside for you, exalted for you, or brought low for you; let me be full, let me be empty, let me have all things, let me have nothing..."

In our culture we tend to prize our ability to make decisions and choose our own path in life. It can feel very hard to give that up. But this prayer is like a love poem. It is about surrendering to God in love and joy.

All are welcome to share in a Covenant Service, whether you are sharing in the Covenant for the first time, have renewed it annually for many years, or simply want to watch it without taking part.
